Rydym yn uned darpariaeth drochi hwyr yn helpu dysgwyr sy'n dechrau addysg cyfrwng Cymraeg yn ddiweddarach (o 7-11 oed) a disgyblion nad oedd y Gymraeg efallai'n rhan o'u trefn feunyddiol, i ennill y sgiliau a'r hyder sydd eu hangen i barhau â'u dysgu trwy'r Gymraeg. Mae'r canolfan yn croesawu disgyblion o ysgolion Saesneg sydd eisiau trosglwyddo i addysg gyfrwng Gymraeg. Yn gyffredinol, bydd plant yn ymuno â'r uned am gyfnod dysgu dwys o tua 12 wythnos cyn mynd trwy gyfnod o integreiddio a phontio i leoliadau prif ffrwd cyfrwng Cymraeg yn Nhorfaen. Mae ein enw, 'Carreg Lam', yn meddwl 'stepping stone' yn Saesneg oherwydd rydym yn bont i ddyfodol dwyieithog ar gyfer pob disgybl.

About Us

We are a late immersion provision unit set up to help learners entering Welsh-medium education at a later stage (between 7-11) and pupils for whom Welsh may not have been part of their daily routine, to gain the skills and confidence needed to continue their learning through Welsh. The centre welcomes pupils from English schools who want to transfer to Welsh medium education. Children generally will join the unit for an intense learning period of approximately 12 weeks before then undergoing a period of transitioned integration into Welsh-language main stream settings within Torfaen. Our name, 'Carreg Lam', means stepping stone because we are a bridge into a new bilingual future for every pupil.

Addysgu a Dysgu

- Canolfan addysg drochi arloesol, sydd yn seiliedig ar arbenigedd ac yn cyfoethogi'r profiad addysgu a dysgu yn ogystal ag annog rhagoriaeth yn y maes.

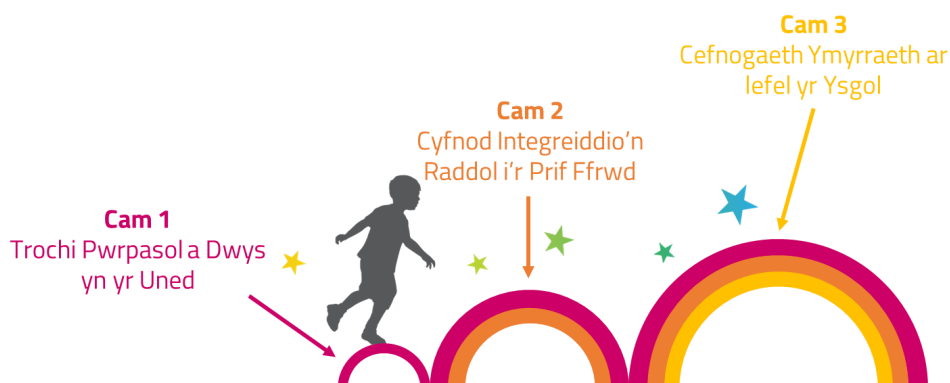
Cefnogaeth Dysgu'r Iaith

Rhagwelir bod disgyblion yn mynychu Carreg Lam ar gyfer 12 wythnos er mwyn dysgu'r iaith mewn ffordd strwythedig a phwrpasol, wedi arwain gan arbenigwyr, cyn trosglwyddo i'r prif ffrwd o fewn ysgol gyfrwng Gymraeg yn Nhorfaen. Dysgir geirfa, patrymau ieithyddol a strwythurau'r iaith trwy ddulliau sydd wedi'u profi i weithio (megis chwarae rôl, gemau, drilio iaith). Golygir hyn fod disgyblion yn meddu ar ryglder sylfaenol yn y Gymraeg, yn gallu defnyddio'r Gymraeg mewn amrywiaeth o sefyllfaoedd, yn datblygu sgiliau meddwl ac yn cael eu paratoi ar gyfer mynychu ysgol gyfrwng Gymraeg.

Yn dilyn y 12 wythnos cychwynnol hyn, lle mae'r plant yn profi dysgu ieithyddol dwys er mwyn ysgogi sgiliau iaith sylfaenol, mae'r canolfan yn parhau i'w cefnogi trwy ymweliadau, cydweithio gyda'r ysgolion a mewnnoli cynllun wedi'u personoli o strategaethau a chymorth.

Tair Carreg Lam

Mae ein cymorth dysgu iaith, felly, yn digwydd mewn tri cham ac mae'r lefel o gymorth a darpariaeth sydd angen ar bob plentyn yn amrywio o fewn y camau hyn.



Sut fydd fy mhlentyn yn ymdopi?

Yng Ngharreg Lam, rydyn ni'n blaenoriaethu lles ein disgyblion, staff a rhieni. Mae ethos o deulu yng nghalon popeth rydyn ni'n gwneud er mwyn sicrhau amgylchedd hapus a diogel. Rydym yn cadw golwg manwl ar ddatblygiad a theimladau'r disgyblion ynghyd â monitro cyson o'u perfformiad. Sicrhewb bod eich plentyn yn derbyn cyfleoedd dyddiol i ymgysylltu gyda disgyblion oed eu hunain a gofal llesol. Rydym wedi ymrwymo i gefnogi iechyd emosiynol a lles ein plant drwy:

- helpu plant i ddeall eu hemosiynau a theimladau yn well;
- helpu plant i deimlo'n gyfforddus trwy rannu unrhyw bryderon;
 - helpu plant i greu perthnasau positif.
- hybu hunan-barch a sicrhau fod plant yn gwybod eu bod nhw'n bwysig;
- annog plant i fod yn hyderus a dathlu ein cymuned a'n hetifeddiaeth;
- helpu plant i ddatblygu gwytnwch emosiynol ag i ymdopi gyda rhwystrau bywyd.

How will my child learn the language?

Support with Learning the Language

It is anticipated that pupils attend Carreg Lam for 12 weeks in order to learn the language in a structured and purposeful way, guided by experts, before transferring to a mainstream class within a Welsh medium school in Torfaen. Vocabulary, linguistic patterns and language structures are taught through methods that have been proven to work (such as role playing, games, language drills). This means that pupils have a foundational fluency in the Welsh language, can access the ability to use the Welsh language in a variety of situations, develop thinking skills and are prepared for attending a Welsh medium school.

Following these initial 12 weeks, where the children experience intensive language learning in order to stimulate basic language skills, the centre continues to support them through visits, collaboration with their school and creating a personalised plan of strategies and support.

Three Stepping Stones

Our language learning support, therefore, takes place in three stages and the level of support and provision each child needs varies within these stages.



How will my child cope?

At Carreg Lam, we prioritise the wellbeing of our pupils, staff and parents. The ethos of being a family is at the heart of everything we do to ensure a happy and safe environment. We keep a close eye on the pupils' development and feelings along with constant monitoring of their performance. We ensure that your child receives daily opportunities to engage with pupils of their own age and active care. We are committed to supporting the emotional health and wellbeing of our children by:

- *helping children to understand their emotions and feelings better;*
- *helping children feel comfortable sharing any concerns or worries;*
 - *helping children socially to form and maintain relationships;*
- *promoting self-esteem and ensure children know that they count;*
 - *encouraging children to be confident and celebrate who we are;*
- *helping children to develop emotional resilience and to manage setbacks.*

Tegwch a Diogelwch | Fairness and Safety

Y pennaeth, Dr. Matthew James Williamson-Dicken, yw'r swyddog amddiffyn plant dynodedig ar gyfer Carreg Lam. Yn absenoldeb y pennaeth, Ms. Nerys Phillips (Dirprwy Ysgol Panteg) sy'n gyfrifol. Mae staff yr ganolfan yn derbyn hyfforddiant blynyddol wedi'i ddiweddarau ynghylch materion amddiffyn plant.

The head, Dr. Matthew James Williamson-Dicken, is the designated child protection officer for Carreg Lam. In the absence of the head, Ms. Nerys Phillips (Deputy of Ysgol Panteg) is responsible. The centre staff receive annual updated training regarding child protection issues.

Credwn fod pob unigolyn, o ba bynnag allu, hil, crefydd neu gefndir yn haeddu cyfle cyfartal i lwyddo yn y ganolfan hon. Rydym yn falch o fod yn ysgol sy'n croesawu disgyblion, staff a rhieni o wahanol gefndiroedd cymdeithasol, hil, rhywioldeb, anabledd, crefydd, iaith, cyfeiriadedd rhywiol ac oedran. Ymdrechwn i greu cymuned sy'n dathlu amrywiaeth yn hytrach na rhagfarn.

Anabledd | Disabilities

Dyluniwyd adeilad y ganolfan (Ysgol Panteg) i ddarparu mynediad i ddisgyblion a staff ag anableddau corfforol, fel a ganlyn:

- Mae'n hawdd cyrraedd y brif fynedfa;
- Mae'n hawdd agor drysau (dolenni isel);
- Toiledau i'r anabl;
- Coridorau eang a drysau ystafell ddosbarth eang;
- Mynediad hawdd i neuadd yr ysgol a mynediad i'r maes chwarae ar un lefel.

The centre's building (Ysgol Panteg) is designed to provide access to pupils and staff with physical disabilities, as follows:

- Main entrance is easily accessed;
- Doors are easily opened (low handles);
- Disabled toilets;
- Wide corridors and wide classroom doors;
- Easy access to school hall and playground access on one level.

Mynediad at y Cwricwlwm | Access to the Curriculum

Mae cwricwlwm y ganolfan yn gytbwys ac yn eang, ac yn cynnig cyfleoedd i bawb lwyddo. Trefnir gweithgareddau'n ofalus gan roi ystyriaeth i'r canlynol:

- Gallu academiaidd pob disgybl;
- Gallu corfforol pob disgybl;
- Diddordeb a thalent pob disgybl;
- Cefndir crefyddol pob disgybl;
- Cefndir cymdeithasol pob disgybl;
- Cefndir ethnig pob disgybl.

The centre's curriculum is balanced and broad, and offers opportunities for all to succeed. Activities are organised carefully with consideration given to the following:

- Academic ability of each pupil;
- Physical ability of each pupil;
- Interest and talent of each pupil;
- Religious background of each pupil;
- Social background of each pupil;
- Ethnic background of each pupil.

Ysgolion Torfaen | Torfaen Schools
